

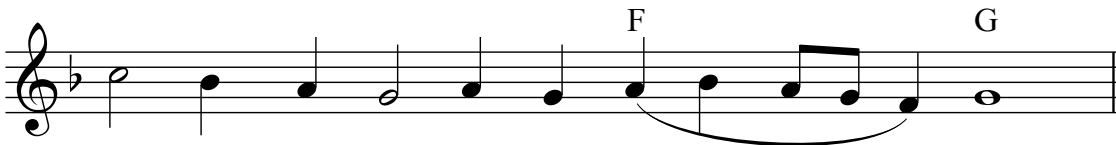
In Everlasting Remembrance
